Good morning, Head Baseball Coaches & AD's –

As we head into the first week of competitions, I wanted to get a few reminders and some final information out as we go into mid-May and the start of June approaches.

1. Data Entry on Bound

Coaches, a reminder of your responsibility to enter game results and stats, including pitch count, into Bound. We should all be well accustomed to this at this point and should be entered within **24 hours** of each contest.

2. Classifications

Final baseball classifications are now posted [HERE](#). No added or discontinued coops will be accepted at this point unless it does not alter these final classifications.

3. Pitch Count

I have had a few questions on pitch count so please make sure you know tiers for this, weekly limitations first three weeks for 10th-12th graders is 180, while 8th-9th graders limit of 150 pitches per week the entire season. Review for most.
