Once we have compiled the qualifying list, we will post on the respective organization's web site as we want to double check that we have the correct name, spelling, and grade level for each of your athletes. If you have qualified a team and know you will be substituting at the state meet at this moment, please respond to this email with that substitution. Team substitutes can still be made the day of the meet by reporting the new participants' name to the packet pickup area immediately upon your arrival at the meet site.

We will be providing wristbands to participating schools for competing athletes, coaches, and/or managers. Ten wristbands for each qualifying team and 3 for individual qualifier, plus one for each additional qualifier. Wristbands are in place to ensure only athletes and essential team personnel competing in the state meet are in the starting area.

If you have additional personnel with your team or individual(s) above and beyond the allotted amount, we will simply invoice your school for additional personnel to ensure no one with the team is charged for parking [12 for team 4(+1) for individual(s)]. **DO NOT HAVE ATHLETES WITH TEAM PURCHASE TICKET.** IF YOU HAVE STUDENTS TRAVELING IN A SCHOOL VEHICLE OF ANY KIND DO NOT HAVE THEM PURCHASE A TICKET. The IGHSAU will invoice the school for the additional personnel to simplify the entry process and again avoid the charge for parking for additional school team traveling party.
